

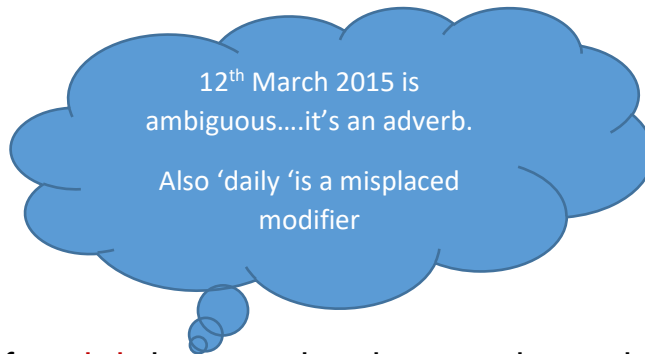
Integrated emergency protection services for disabled in **Puntland and South and Central Somalia** in displacement affected areas

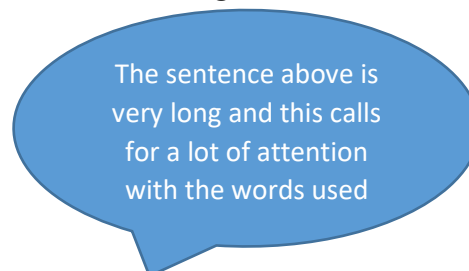
Needs:



According **Amnesty International**, **12th March 2015**, Somalia's displaced people have spent years being driven from place to place by conflict, drought and famine, facing untold hardships, mistreatment and abuse.



They face **daily** human rights abuses such as unlawful killings, violence including rape and other forms of sexual violence, forced evictions, lack of access to health **or an** adequate standard of living such as housing, food, water **as well as** limited access to humanitarian assistance.

This **briefing** is not an in-depth analysis into the **experiences** of persons with disabilities in Somalia. Instead it seeks to highlight the **severity** of the abuses persons with disabilities suffer, with the aim of **galvanising** attention to their dire situation, encouraging the Somali Federal Government to engage with persons with disabilities and ensure their protection.
